Outdoor Worship Policy

The policy that has been approved by church council and will be followed for outdoor services is as follows:

- 1. Please wear a face mask at all times. Please bring your own if possible. Some face masks will be available if you don't have one. Exceptions: children under 2 and those with medical conditions that affect breathing
- 2. You are encouraged to stay home if you are in a high-risk group. Worship services will be recorded and available online by Tuesday following the service.
- 3. Please bring chairs from home and take them home with you following worship.
- 4. Food and coffee will NOT be served.
- 5. Maintain 6 ft. distance from other households. Please do not make physical contact with anyone outside your household. Parents, please keep an eye on your children. The playground will be closed.
- 6. Opportunities for offering will be in a stationary location when you exit the worship space. Please continue online giving if possible.
- 7. Attendance will be taken by the usher or greeter. At some point during the service a picture or pictures will be taken of the group in order to contact people in the event of virus exposure. The pictures will only be for church use.
- 8. Please take your bulletin home with you following the service.
- 9. If you or someone in your household is ill, please enjoy worship online and do not attend the service. If you have been exposed to COVID-19 within 2 weeks, please do not attend worship. If you have tested positive for the virus, please stay home for the time recommended by the CDC.
- 10. Songs will not be sung as a group. Solos and other music will be used when possible.
- 11. Please refrain from social gathering following worship. Please maintain social distancing while you leave.
